## OUR MISSION

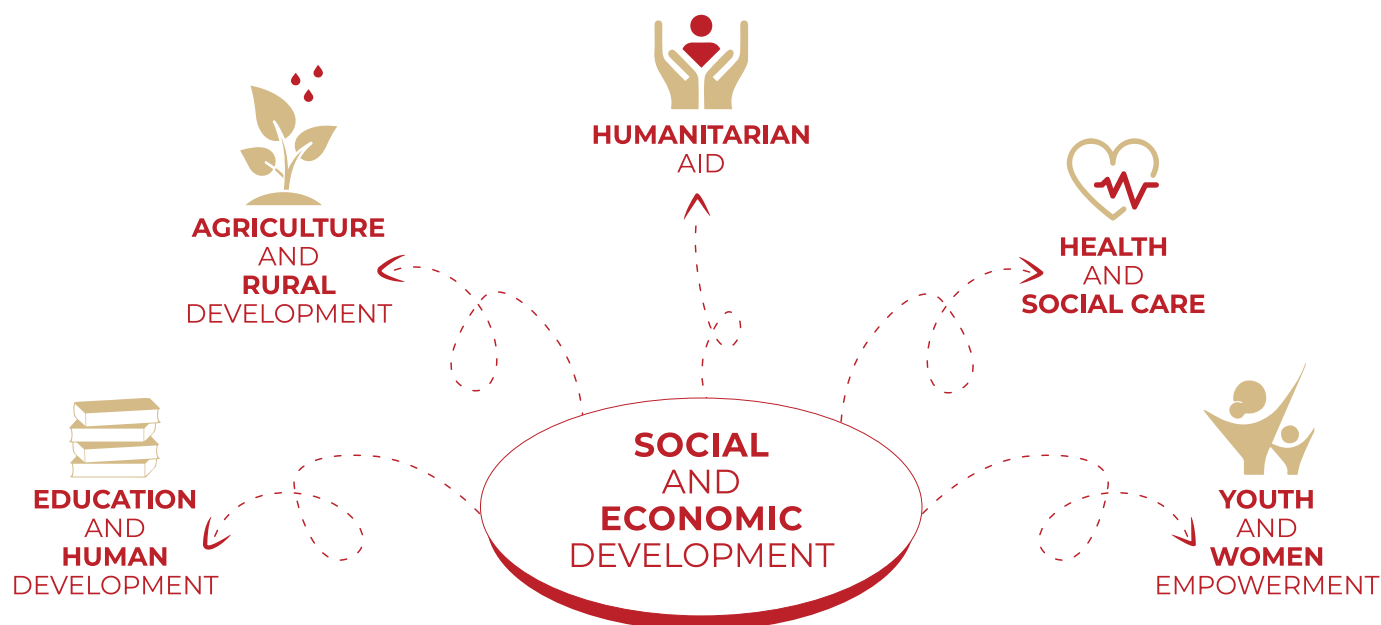

FSF seeks to create sustainable livelihoods and achieve sustainable development in the Lebanese community.

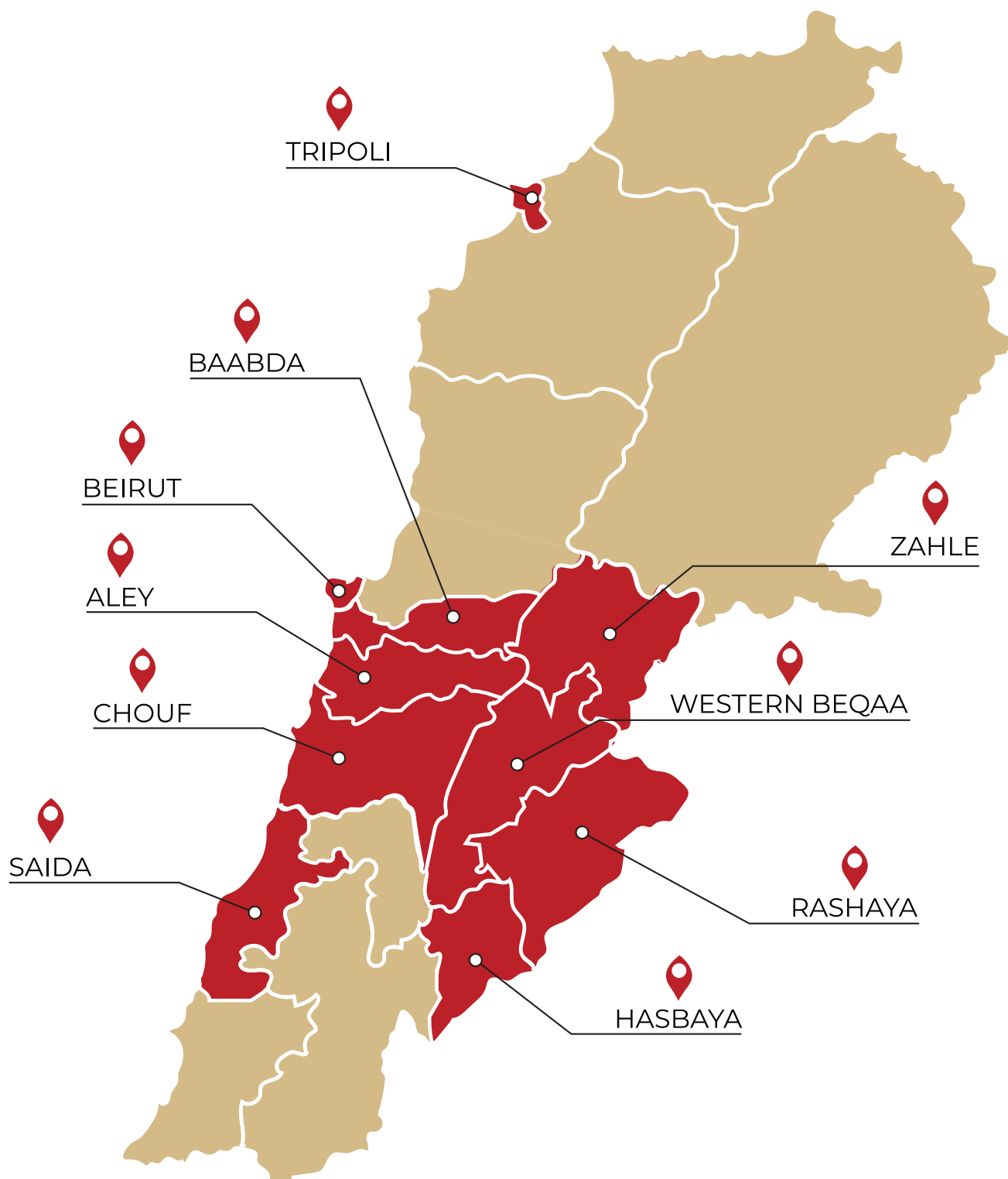
