Our Mission



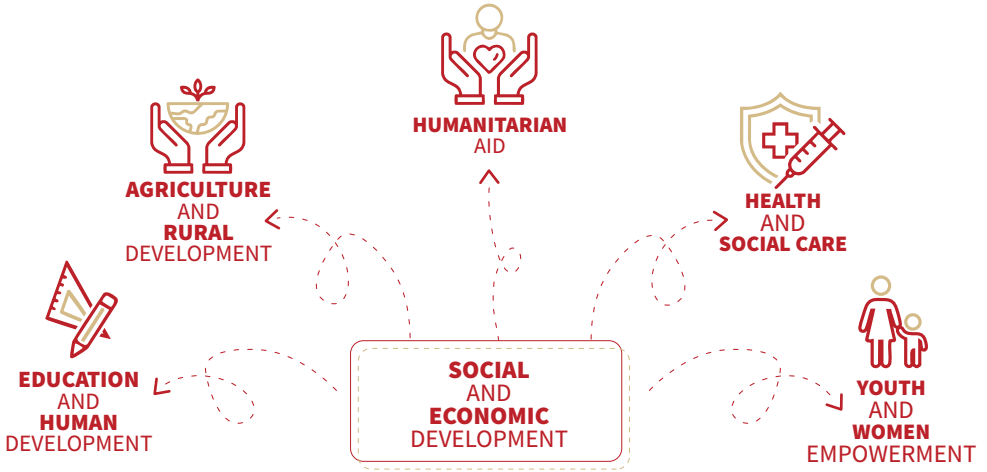

Our Vision

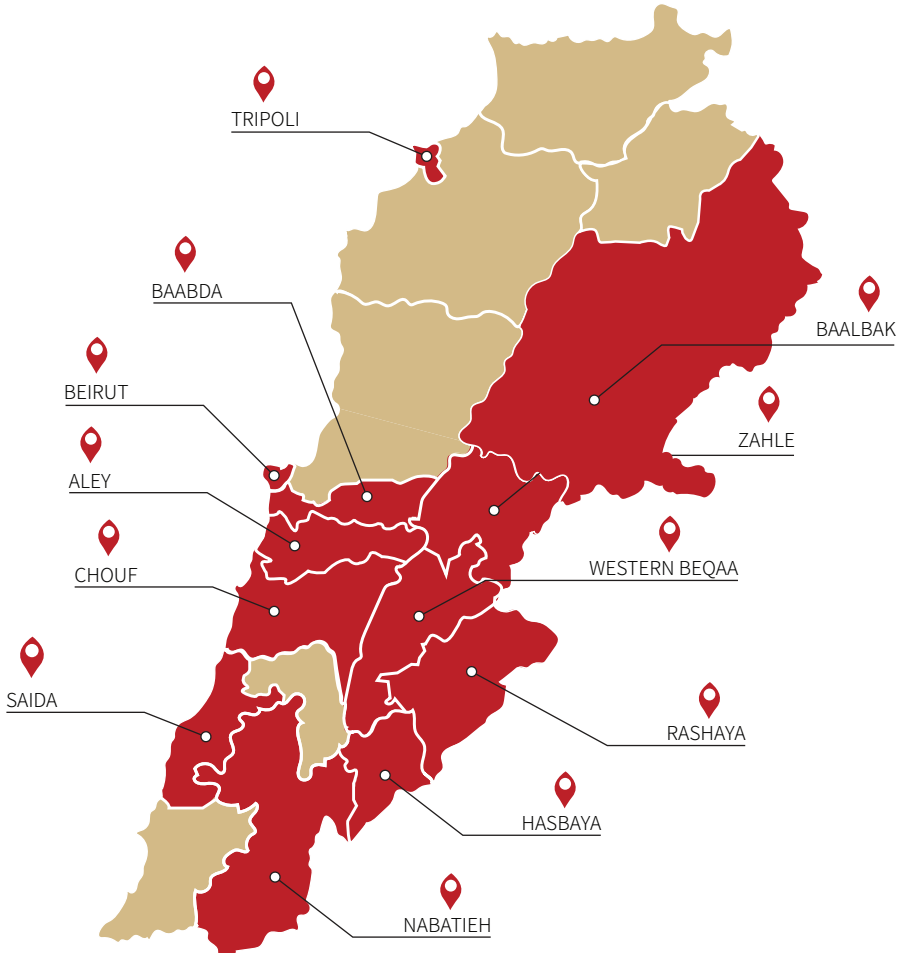
